



What you need:

- Windows Media Player on PC
(Captions are not available on Windows Media Player for the Mac.)
- Video file (.wmv or .mpg)
- Caption file (.smi)

Step 1: Open your video

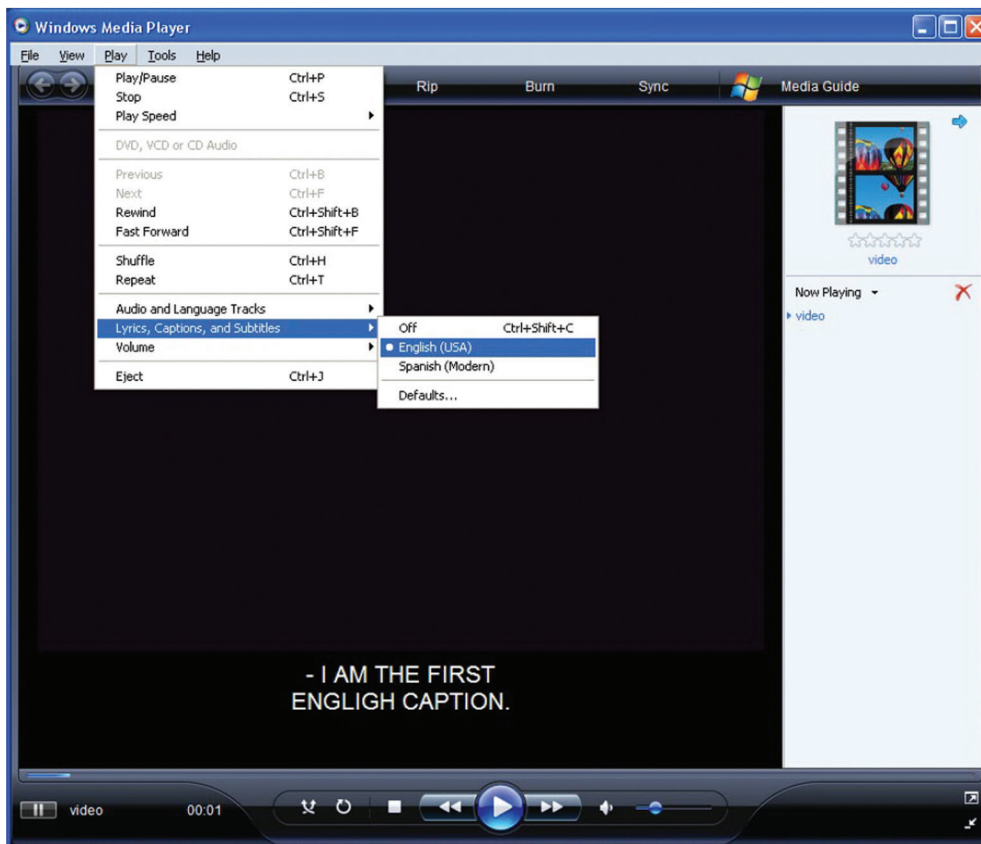
- Place your video file and caption file in the same folder.
- Right-click on the video file and choose “Open With” then choose Windows Media Player.
- Go to Full Mode (View > Full Mode or Ctrl-1)
Captions will not play in Skin Mode.

Step 2: Enable captions

- Go to Tools > Options. Click on the Security tab and make sure “Show local captions when present” is turned on.

Step 3: Choose your captions and play

- Go to Play > Lyrics, Captions and Subtitles. (“Captions and Subtitles” for older versions)
- Choose from the available languages and press Play. (**Ctrl-Shift-C** will turn on/off captions.)

- Captions and subtitles will play in a black box below the video.
